

Saskatchewan College of Podiatrists—Regulatory Bylaws

BYLAWS PURSUANT TO *THE PODIATRY ACT*

Title

1. These bylaws may be cited as *The College of Podiatrists Limited Liability Partnerships Bylaws*.

Definitions

2. In these bylaws:

“college” means the Saskatchewan College of Podiatrists;

“limited liability partnership” or “LLP” means a limited liability partnership provided for under Part IV of *The Partnership Act*;

“member” means a member of the college;

“registrar” means the registrar of the college.

Limited Liability Partnerships (LLP)

- 3(1) A partnership of members that intends to apply to the Corporations Branch to be registered as an LLP shall forward to the registrar a copy of the proposed application, together with a fee of \$150 for the provision of the statement required by clause 86(4)(f) of *The Partnership Act*, and any other information necessary to process the application.
- (2) The registrar shall, upon receiving the material mentioned in subsection (1), review the status of each partner listed in the application and provide the partnership with a certificate certifying that each proposed partner in the LLP is or is not a member of the college, and shall include any conditions or limitations on his or her practice.
- (3) Upon registration, an LLP shall immediately give notice to all its existing clients advising of its registration and explaining in general terms the potential changes in liability to the partners.

Proposed changes in partners

- 4(1) An LLP shall notify the registrar in writing of any proposed change in the partnership.
- (2) The registrar shall, upon receiving a notice of a proposed change under subsection (1), review the status of each partner listed in the application and provide the partnership with a certificate certifying that each proposed partner in the LLP is or is not a member of the college, and shall include any conditions or limitations on

his or her practice.

Register of LLPs

- 5 The registrar shall keep a register of all LLP's in which members are partners, including the names and addresses of all partners, and any limitations on the practice of the LLP.

Coming into force

- 6 In accordance with section 13 of *The Podiatry Act*, these bylaws come into force when they are approved by the Minister of Health and are published in the Gazette.
